


Example Sign Permit Site Plan (Ground Mounted Signs)



Site plans are a drawing of the property from a bird's eye view. The following **required** items have been included in the site plan for submittal acceptance (check each box as drawn):



- Adjacent Streets
- Property Line
- Ground Mounted Sign Location(s) – Existing and Proposed
- Ground Mounted Sign Setback(s) – distance to the property line(s) adjacent to a street
- Distance Between Ground Mounted Signs (on the same property, as applicable)
- Sign Number Labels (i.e., G1, G2...as listed in sign permit application)
- Curb / Street Line Location

Optional items that have been included are (check only those which apply):

- Sight Triangles (no signage above 30" is allowed within the sight triangle)
- Landscape Areas (if applying for bonus signage area)
- Street Frontage (length of property line along an adjacent street)

Example Sign Permit Elevation

(Wall Mounted Signs)



Elevations are a drawing of your property from the street view. The following required items have been included in the elevations for submittal acceptance (check each box as drawn):

- Wall Dimensions
- Wall Sign Location(s) and Dimensions
- Location of Existing Wall Mounted Sign(s) (as applicable; only those that will remain)
- Projection Distance and Mounting Height (for all signs which project more than 18" from the wall)
- Elevation (Wall) Location (Front, Rear, Side or N.W.S.E. or Street Name)
- Sign Number Labels (i.e., W1, W2...as listed in sign permit application)

Optional items which have been included are (check only those that apply):

- Wall Details (doors, windows or other architectural details)
- Dimensions of Existing Wall Mounted Sign(s) (as applicable; only those that will remain)
- Detailed Sign Drawings with Dimensions (for irregular shaped signs)
