

WORKREATION PROGRAM- (REC DOLLAR PROGRAM)

Did you know? When you volunteer with the Brighton Recreation Center designated classes, programs and Special Events, you will earn TWO Recreation Dollars for each hour worked. Rec Dollars may be applied toward payment of daily admission, 15-visit, quarterly or annual passes.

HIGH SCHOOL COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRAM

For the past 13 years, high school student volunteers have completed their High School Community Service with the City of Brighton. Students have assisted with many duties such as clerical, parks, special events, working with youth, sports, etc. Volunteer opportunities in the area of Special Events are scheduled year round. Duties include prop and float building, set-up and takedown, as well as working the event. High school volunteers have also acted as a costume person during parades and community special events. Many departments in the city have benefited by youths completing their requirements for high school graduation.
