2018 FULL MOON BIKE RIDES RECAP



The 2018 Bike Brighton Full Moon Bike Rides dealt with weather issues this year, with only one ride that had beautiful weather. All other monthly rides had rain storms during the ride or storms that ended when the bike ride began, tornado warning 3 hours before one ride, and wind and more wind.

At each monthly ride nearly half of the participants were new riders to the Full Moon Bike Rides. **The average 2018 Full Moon Bike Ride participation was 21 riders.** The following is the actual account of riders per month.

June 2018 Full Moon Bike Ride	29 participants
July 2018 Full Moon Bike Ride	18 participants
August 2018 Full Moon Bike Ride	17 participants

Total Riders in 2018	124 participants
Average per Month	21 participants (20.67)
