



LET LIGHT BE YOUR FRIEND

Criminals will typically bypass well-lit homes in favor of darker homes that appear empty. Some safety tips to help prevent crime throughout the City of Brighton:

- Make sure your home is well-lit. The National Crime Prevention Council says increased lighting can decrease crime by 20%.
- Turn on your porch light. Leaving a standard 60-watt porch light on every night only costs about \$1.75 a month!
- If you notice a streetlight is out, please contact United Power at www.UnitedPower.com/report-street-light-problems/.
- Consider motion detector lights in the back of your home and in the alley, if you
 have one. More light equals less crime.
- While on vacation, connect lamps to automatic times that turn them on in the evening and off during the day.
- Always be aware of your surroundings and REPORT suspicious activity.
