

MEMORIAL TREE PROGRAM

Do you want to acknowledge the loss of a loved one, birth of a child, or celebrate a personal achievement or milestone?

- The Memorial Tree Program enables Brighton citizens to donate trees to the city.
- Trees may be planted in any park or trail that the Brighton Parks and Open Space Department takes care of.
- The donator will be able to choose from a list of approved tree species which will be provided through the Brighton Forestry Department.
- Most trees will cost the donator approximately \$150.
- The City forester will aid the donator in proper placement and selection of the trees.
- The Forestry Department will plant and maintain the donated trees.
- Plaques and signage of any kind will NOT be allowed to be placed next to the memorial trees however...

A new memorial exhibit is located at the new city hall. The exhibit includes the following:

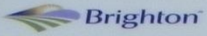
