Produce Sourcing

FBR partners with several growers in the Brighton/Weld County area


- Produce is purchased at reduced rates (seconds or product that cannot be sold retail)
- Receive as donations

In 2019, we procured through purchasing or donations

- 97,720 lbs of green beans, cabbage, and leafy greens from Petrocco Farms
- 201,510 lbs of carrots from Hungenberg Produce
- 297,350 lbs of onions from Sakata Farms

In total, that's 596,580 lbs of locally sourced produce!


Produce Distribution

- Ordered through Agency Express (our ordering system)
- PUSH program
- Shared with our branches

Our PUSH produce program is a no-cost program offered by Food Bank of the Rockies to increase fresh produce distribution

- Full - and half-pallets of produce
- Pallets are usually 2,000 lbs - half-pallets are 1,000 pounds

Agencies can receive these on a weekly, bi-weekly, or other frequency basis depending on their needs. Produce distributed depends on what we have on hand; arrangements are made in advance with Colleen.


