

# UTILITIES REPORT

## FEBRUARY 2022



### WATER

- Water Treatment Plant design progressing
- Preparing for Sanitary Survey which will be in March 2022
- 2.0 elevated tank on schedule to be completed by Dec. 2022 and on budget
- Additional BeeBe well will be put into service in 2022
- Non-Potable water system being developed
- Water Treatment Plant Info:
  - Peak Demand = 3.183 MG
  - Peak Day Production = 3.087 MG
  - Daily Average Demand= 2.961 MG
  - Daily Average Production = 1.303 MG
  - Total Produced = 36.492 MG



### WASTEWATER

- Design on Chemical Building is Continuing
- Bar Screen Modification discussion has begun
- Waste Water Treatment Plant Info:
  - Peak Demand = 1.401 MGD
  - Daily Average Demand = 1.286 MGD
  - Total Treated = 36.003 MG

### COLLECTION/DISTRIBUTION

- Water Main Breaks - 4
- 11 After hours service calls
- 26 New Meter installed
- 226 Service orders
- 21 Meter pit inspections (new builds)

### ENGINEERING

- Water Treatment Plant design is proceeding
- The 2.0 elevated tank construction is happening
- Non-potable water master plan is waiting for contract approval before beginning.
- Water main replacement - Staff anticipates going out to bid soon
- South Adam Interconnect - construction notice released and construction expected to start in March



### WATER RESOURCES

- Conducting exploration drilling to identify potential new well locations for treatment and irrigation
- Monthly report sent to state for water accounting
- Acquired 28.44 water shares

### STORM WATER

- North Outfall-Baseline alignment Project
  - Scheduled anticipated start March 21, 2022.
  - Temporary easements and overall agreement with Mountain View has been signed and recorded.
  - Grein property easement agreement has been signed and recorded.
  - Stamped and signed civil plans should be submitted this week.
  - Ditch crossing agreements are currently in review with the respective companies.
- Continue to support Parks on the Recreation Center Pond Lining to save on water and cost.
- 2021 Annual Report has been signed and submitted to the CDPHe.
- All 2021 MS4 compliance documentation has been added to the 2021 binder.
- Developing a new "Stormwater Utility" webpage. Webpage is in draft form awaiting approval of the City Attorney to update.
- Support Public Works on review of the Bridge Widening project.
