Case Report 22-6751

On Dec. 13, at approximately 3:42 p.m., Brighton Police Officers responded to a shoplifting in progress at Walgreens on East Bridge Street. Two females were discovered to be in possession of stolen merchandise, drug paraphernalia, an illegal identification document, multiple stolen debit cards and 0.78 grams of methamphetamine. One female also had two active warrants. They were accompanied by a 9-year-old child. Both females were taken into custody and transported to the Adams County Detention Facility. Child Protective Services was notified about the incident. This case remains an active investigation.

**THIS WEEK'S CRIME PREVENTION TIP**

- Make it clear if you have a home security system.
- Keep porch areas clear and visible.
- If you will not be home at the time of delivery, ask a neighbor to get your packages for you.
