SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 23-0068

On Jan. 4, at around 7:50 p.m., officers were dispatched to a business in the 100 block of North Main Street to investigate a reported case of fraud. Officers spoke with the business owner and learned that an employee was scammed into wire transferring \$21,604 to numerous banks in Mexico. The business owner had been wanting to upgrade their point of sale system, and had recently contacted a third party company to inquire about a new system. Days later, an employee received a call at the business from someone claiming to be with a point of sale system company (the company was not named). This person stated that the business owner had agreed to purchase the system and that the employee would need to complete a wire transfer to pay for it. The employee followed the necessary steps to transfer money to 16 different recipients, totaling \$21,604. The business owner never agreed to purchase a point of sale system. This case is currently under investigation by the Brighton Police Department.

THIS WEEK'S SAFETY TIP

January is Colorado Human Trafficking Awareness Month. Traffickers can be of any race, gender, or social or economic status. Often a trafficker is someone the victim knows and trusts such as an intimate partner, employer, friend, or family member. Traffickers use force, fraud, and/or coercion to control victims, and prevent them from escaping the situation. A trafficker might make promises of a better life, offer legal status, make threats or become violent.

It can be difficult to know for sure if someone is being trafficked. They may not even understand it themselves. It is a complex crime. Some indicators include (but are not limited to):

- They are not being paid for work, or are being paid very little
- They are not being paid for work because they owe the employer for food or housing or other necessities
- They are being coerced into engaging in commercial sex
- They are being watched
- They are not permitted to speak for themselves or go anywhere by themselves
- They are being bullied, yelled at, physically handled roughly, or being intimidated
- They appear afraid
- There are signs of injury or illness that have not been addressed. This could also include malnourishment.
