SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 23-0164

On Jan. 11 at 12:38 a.m., officers responded to 126 West Bridge Street (Paisano's Liquors) for a business burglary alarm. Officers learned that three male suspects used a crowbar to smash the front door of the liquor store where they stole beer and numerous vape pens. Suspects left in a dark gray 2015 - 2017 Ford F-150 Raptor. After hitting Paisano's, suspects and vehicle are believed to be involved in three other burglaries in adjacent jurisdictions, all occurring between 12:38 and 2:12 a.m. Brighton Police Officers continue to gather evidence and follow up with this case.

Case Report 23-0225

On Jan. 13 around 11:50 a.m., community service officers received reports of possible animal neglect where several turtles, fish and bearded dragons were in a bedroom without adequate food or water. It was discovered that the animals belonged to a roommate who had not been home in several weeks, and the 80-year-old resident along with his caretakers were growing concerned for the animals well-being. When officers arrived, they discovered a room that was infested with insects along with 14 Lizards, 12 fish, and 7 turtles who were in poor health and an unlivable environment. All the animals were taken to the Riverdale Animal Shelter. The owner was contacted and officers are working on charges at this time.

Case Report 23-0248, 23-0249, 23-0253

On Jan. 14 around 7:45 p.m., officers responded to Walmart on reports of a shoplift in progress. Upon locating and searching the suspect, officers recovered drug paraphernalia, 1.7 grams of methamphetamine and 66 blue M30 fentanyl pills. This individual was processed and transported to Adams County Detention Facility.

Following this, officers searched a vehicle in the Walmart parking lot that was related to the shoplift in progress. The vehicle was occupied by two people, who were initially uncooperative. After successfully detaining both people without incident, officers found more drug paraphernalia and 102 additional blue M30 fentanyl pills. Both individuals were processed and transported to Adams County Detention Facility.

Later that evening, around 10:30 p.m., officers were once again dispatched to Walmart in reference to a known offender with an active felony warrant. This individual was taken into custody and transported to the Adams County Detention Facility. Upon searching the individual, officers discovered 25 blue M30 fentanyl pills.

THIS WEEK'S CRIME PREVENTION TIP

Motor vehicle thefts tend to increase in the colder months! We want to share some reminders with you from the Colorado Auto Theft Prevention Authority.

- Puffing your car – or leaving it running unattended – is illegal in Colorado with one exception: Colorado law does exempt vehicles with a remote-start from being ticketed if found running unattended.
- Never leave your car running unattended.
- In cold weather, warm up WITH your car: grab a hot cup of coffee, gloves and a blanket. Most cars warm up in a matter of minutes.
- Park in an enclosed garage whenever possible.
- Use a remote start if you have one, making sure the doors are locked and the keyless start fob is far enough away that the vehicle can't be moved.
- Lock your doors every single time.
- Always park in well-lit areas.
