SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 23-3697

On July 3 just before 10 a.m. officers responded to the 2200 block of Prairie Center Parkway for a shoplift in progress. Store employees reported that there were two individuals loading up a cart with high valued items. Upon arrival officers noticed a suspicious vehicle with no license plates and an obstructed VIN. One of the reported individuals checked out at the store, and then began running from officers through the parking lot. Multiple units responded and the suspect was quickly taken into custody.

The receipt from the store showed that the suspect had used a stolen debit card. While searching the associated vehicle, officers discovered drug paraphernalia, methamphetamine and multiple stolen IDs and debit/credit cards. The suspect was processed and transported to Adams County jail.




Case Report 23-3743

On July 5 around 9 a.m., Brighton police officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Dove Avenue on reports of a recovered stolen vehicle. When officers arrived they contacted a friend of the victim (vehicle owner). The victim had a GPS tracker on the vehicle and noticed that it had been in the same location in Brighton for an hour. The victim asked her friend to respond to the location on Dove Avenue to look for her vehicle. The vehicle was found and the friend contacted the police. Police officers canvassed the neighborhood and found doorbell footage showing several individuals, mostly juveniles, running from the stolen vehicle. Officers were able to locate the individual at a nearby home. Through their investigation, they identified a juvenile male as the person responsible for stealing the car. When the juvenile was arrested he became combative with police officers and other staff. He spit on and kicked officers while in police custody. He was later booked into the Juvenile Detention Center.

Case Report 23-3830

On July 9 at approximately 6 p.m. Brighton Police Officers were dispatched to 13th Avenue and Bridge Street for a crash involving a motorcycle. When officers arrived they learned a Volkswagen making a left hand turn onto Bridge Street from South 13th Avenue turned in front of a motorcyclist traveling eastbound on Bridge Street. Drugs or alcohol are not suspected to be factors in the crash. The motorcyclist was transported to the hospital with non-fatal but serious injuries.

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 23-3783

On July 6 at about 11 p.m. officers conducted a traffic stop in the area of US Highway 85 and West Bromley Lane. The driver was found to have an active warrant out of the Denver Marshall's Office. After the suspect was secured, Officers returned to the vehicle and observed drug paraphernalia and began a probable cause search of the vehicle.

A backpack was located with a handgun in the main compartment. There was no round in the chamber, but the magazine was loaded. There was also another loaded magazine and multiple loose 9mm rounds in the backpack. In the small zipper compartment, Officers located a baggie of approximately 200 blue M30 fentanyl pills.

In the glovebox there was another pistol with a loaded magazine and the serial number had been cut off and removed. An additional loaded magazine was located in the glove box. In the trunk of the vehicle was another backpack with several stolen ID cards, debit cards and social security cards. While fingerprinting the suspect he stated, "I just really like drugs." He was processed and transported to Adams County jail.



Case Report 23-3727


On July 4 at approximately 5 p.m., Community Services Officers and Brighton Police Officers were dispatched to an apartment complex on Walnut Street on reports of a dog attack. When officers arrived they found that a 44 year-old man had been attacked by two dogs and sustained serious injuries from the attack. The man who lived in the complex believed he was at his apartment and opened the unlocked door to the apartment. When he opened the door two large dogs exited the apartment and aggressively attacked the man. The man later realized he was on the wrong floor of the apartment complex and had inadvertently entered the wrong unit.

Case Report 23-3821

While on patrol at Home Depot, officers located a vehicle that had previously eluded them. Officers waited for the occupants of the vehicle to return to the vehicle to speak to them about the previous eluding case. When the owner returned to the vehicle officers asked the occupants for permission to search the vehicle. The occupants allowed the officers to search the vehicle and the officer seized nearly 26 grams of suspected methamphetamine. The occupants were arrested for possession of narcotics.
