SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 23-3659

The suspect in this case turned themselves in. As mentioned in previous updates, officers responded to the 3000 block of East Bridge Street on a report of gunshots on July 1. They learned that someone had fired a rifle at the victim's car before driving off. Through the initial investigation officers were able to identify a suspect. This person turned themselves in nine days later.

Case Report 23-3864

On July 11, 2023, Officers conducted a traffic stop when the driver of the vehicle fled on foot. Officers learned the passenger was wanted on five felony warrants with a direct sentence to the Department of Corrections. Officers searched for the wanted felon for about 45 minutes but were initially unsuccessful in locating him. A clerk at a nearby convenience store called the police when they noticed the felon come out of the creek. He was found hiding in a nearby dumpster and arrested.

Case Report 23-3947

On July 15 just before 11 p.m. officers were dispatched to a male starting fights at Jordinelli's and stated he was going to get a gun. The male, a 15-year-old, was located by officers walking north of the bars. He was detained and positively identified. The male refused to give his name and only cursed at officers. He was very intoxicated. Officers transported the male to the police department and he was banging his head against the partition. When he was placed in a cell, he tried to headbutt an officer. Officers were advised he had a protection order for felony menacing. Prairie Vista was able to book him in on multiple charges including Attempt 2nd Degree Assault on a Peace Officer.

Case Report 23-3927

On July 13 officers were dispatched to an animal complaint. Officers arrived and noticed a bull terrier puppy was in a hot car and there was no water in sight. The reporting party said the dog had been in there for hours. The officer contacted the owner and subsequently charged him with Animal Neglect.
