SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 23-4769

On Aug. 22 Officers were dispatched to 1083 S. 8th Ave. regarding a found child. Officers arrived on scene and contacted the reporting party, who stated the child was playing on the playground unattended. The reporting party also said she had been with the child for approximately an hour but thought the 3-year-old had been outside long before. It was about 95 degrees outside.

Officers remained with the child while others went door to door at the apartment complex trying to locate parents for about 45 minutes until the child's mother was located. She stated she had fallen asleep. The child had exited the apartment located on the third floor and was outside unattended for approximately 2 hours. The child's mother was cited for child abuse and CPS was notified.

Case Report 23-4785

On Aug. 23 at 12:10 p.m. officers were dispatched to the King Soopers on Bromley Lane on reports of a male threatening people with a knife. Callers reported a male waving a large knife after a traffic altercation. Multiple people witnessed the incident and called police to report it. The suspect left the scene before police arrived, but a witness was able to get the license plate. The registration listed to a home in Brighton and officers located the vehicle on their way to the address. The suspect was safely taken into custody after a high-risk stop. The knife was located in the vehicle and the suspect was transported to Adams County jail for the charge of felony menacing.

Case Report 23-4846

At 1:41 a.m. on Aug. 26, officers conducted a traffic stop for no license plate lamps. The 23-year-old male driver had an open alcohol container, cash, and smelled of marijuana. Under the driver's seat, officers located 2 loaded handguns with several loaded magazines. Also recovered were over 100 M30 Fentanyl pills and methamphetamine. He was transported to Adams County jail on multiple charges.



Case Report 23-4863

At 8:09 p.m. on Aug. 26 officers were dispatched to an injury crash at US Highway 85 and WCR 2. Several juveniles were seen running from the scene. Upon arrival, officers were able to detain the driver of the vehicle. He was a juvenile who was intoxicated and in possession of a handgun. This was an assist for Weld County Sheriff's Office.
