SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 23-4906

On Aug. 29 officers made a traffic stop for expired plates. On a consent search of the vehicle, they discovered 1.77 grams of methamphetamine and 8.73 grams of M30 pills.

Case Report 23-4943

On Aug. 30, an officer was injured while attempting to contact an individual wanted for burglary. [Read the full news release here.](#) The [17th Judicial District Attorney's Office](#) accepted the following charges against 34-year-old Matthew Lucero:

- 1st-Degree Attempted Murder (F2)
- 1st-Degree Assault on a Peace Officer (F3)
- 2nd-Degree Burglary (F3)
- Attempted Robbery (F5)
- 3rd-Degree Assault (M1)
- Crime of Violence (Sentence Enhancer)

Case Report 23-4954

On Aug. 31 at approximately 12 p.m. Brighton Police officers were dispatched to Benedict Park on a report of a robbery. Upon their arrival, they learned a 77-year-old ice cream truck driver had been robbed and assaulted. The victim reported being struck in the face multiple times by the suspect before they stole his tip jar and ice cream. The victim sustained several facial lacerations and swelling from being struck, but he was able to provide officers with a suspect and vehicle description. This is an ongoing investigation and updates will be released on our website and official Brighton Police social media channels as they become available.

Case Report 23-4947

On Aug. 31 officers were conducting extra patrols near South 3rd Avenue and Bush Street when they contacted a female for having no front lamp on her bicycle. While attempting to pat her down for weapons, the female took off running. Officers were able to catch her and place her into custody. She was identified as a 34-year-old female with an escape warrant from the Department of Corrections.

Case Report 23-4985

On Sept. 2 officers stopped a vehicle and conducted a DUI investigation. The driver didn't have any identification, the vehicle was unregistered, and there was no insurance. The driver was arrested for DUI and brought to the police department. While conducting an inventory of the vehicle, nearly 55 grams of Fentanyl were discovered.



Case Report 23-4988

On Sept. 2 around 2:30 a.m., officers responded to the 300 block of South 22nd Avenue on a trespass in progress. Upon arrival, officers observed the suspect and engaged in a foot pursuit. The 17-year-old male was getting away on an electric scooter after throwing a rock through a house window and breaking several screens. Officers were able to detain the suspect, and they discovered alcohol and another person's license in his backpack.
