SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 23-5566

On Sept. 28 just before 11 p.m. officers were dispatched to the unit block of North Main Street for shots fired. Multiple people called to report seeing a male party fire a single shot while involved in a physical fight. Witnesses stated that everyone who was reportedly involved in the altercation had fled the scene. Officers searched for evidence and interviewed multiple people but were unable to identify a victim.

Case Report 23-5553

On Sept. 28 around 10 a.m. officers were dispatched to the Adams County jail parking lot for a man who thought people were following him. When officers arrived, they contacted a 38-year-old male who was found to be having a mental episode. The male was in possession of two handguns and two knives. He was safely detained and placed on a medical hold.

Case Report 23-5573

On Sept. 29 officers were dispatched to the 100 block of South 18th Avenue around 10:45 a.m. for a crash. Witnesses reported seeing people fleeing the area. Officers arrived and found an ID in the driver's seat for a 22-year-old male. They also found a loaded gun and observed that the vehicle had a punched ignition. Another officer in the area noticed a male and female walking quickly near 13th Avenue and Bridge Street. Officers successfully identified these two individuals as those who had fled from the scene of the crash. Both the vehicle and the handgun involved had been reported stolen out of different jurisdictions. The 22-year-old male was arrested and booked into Adams County jail on multiple charges.

Case Report 23-5614

On Sept. 30 at 11:39 p.m., officers were dispatched to a motorcycle crash near Brighton Road and East 136th Avenue. The reporting party stated they found a motorcycle damaged in the field, and moments later they found the injured rider a short distance away. Officers learned that the driver of the motorcycle, a 29-year-old male, had been under the influence and was riding his motorcycle more than the speed limit before falling off the roadway. He was transported to the hospital with serious injuries.

Case Report 23-4954

Detectives have successfully identified a suspect, 20-year-old Luis Antonio Hernandez, in the assault of an ice cream truck driver that occurred on Aug. 31. A warrant has been issued for his arrest and we are seeking help from the public to locate him. His last known location was in New Mexico. [Read the full news release here.](#)
