## SECTION 1

# SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

### CCase Report 23-5959

On Oct. 17 just before 1:45 a.m. officers were on routine patrol in the 400 block of West Bromley Lane when they noticed a suspicious vehicle that was occupied by two people. Near the vehicle officers could smell a strong chemical burn odor. Upon contacting the occupants, officers noticed drug paraphernalia. After further investigation the suspects were found to be in possession of 23 blue (Fentanyl) pills. The 29-year-old male suspect also had two active warrants. He was processed and then transported to Adams County jail. The 42-year-old female suspect was released from the police department with a summons for possession and drug paraphernalia.



### Case Report 23-6070

On Oct. 22 at 1:40 a.m. officers were dispatched to a disturbance with weapons in the unit block of South 22nd Avenue. Dispatch advised that there was a burglary in progress. After further investigation, officers learned that a female suspect entered a residence through an unlocked door with a knife and threatened the family inside. The family was able to take the knife from her and hold her there until officers arrived. The 31-year-old female was successfully identified, and she was unknown to the family. She was arrested, processed, and transported to Adams County jail.

### Case Report 23-6086, 23-6087

On Oct. 22 at 10:30 a.m. officers received notification from an Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) of a stolen plate. They were able to locate the vehicle and conduct a traffic stop. Upon contact the driver was identified and associated to a felony Denver warrant. The male was taken into custody without incident and transported to Adams County jail. Upon a search of the vehicle, a total of 20 grams of methamphetamine was found.
