SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 23-6108

On Oct. 24 just before 6:30 a.m. officers responded to the 1200 block of South 8th Avenue where an individual reported someone had just attempted to rob them at gunpoint. The victim ran and called 911 and provided a description of the suspect, who had already fled from the area. While multiple officers searched the area, one officer went to a nearby school bus stop to provide extra security. While at the bus stop, a parent notified officers that a suspicious male was hiding at the park nearby. Upon arrival at the park, officers contacted a person matching the suspect description. The juvenile male was found to be in possession of a gun, which was later determined to be stolen. The 17-year-old was arrested on multiple charges including aggravated robbery.



Case Report 23-6178

On Oct. 27 officers were called by a person who witnessed someone leave Walmart with a shopping cart full of clothes. Officers were able to locate both suspects, who were actively stealing a cartload of food. Over \$1500 of stolen property was recovered. A 44-year-old female and a 35-year-old male were arrested and booked into Adams County jail.

Case Report 23-6213

On Oct. 29 just after 4:30 p.m. officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of South 8th Avenue for a 13-month-old baby not breathing. Officers immediately started CPR until medics arrived. The baby was successfully revived and then transported to an area hospital. An investigation was conducted by detectives who discovered evidence of multiple forms of fentanyl on scene. Child Protective Services was notified, and both parents were arrested on charges of felony child abuse. The quick action of the officers who responded to this call saved the child's life.
