# SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

---

### Case Report 23-6369

On Nov. 6 at 6:15 a.m. officers were dispatched to Platte Valley Medical Center for a cold burglary at the pharmacy. The initial investigation revealed that three people smashed the front main lobby door with a crow bar and gained access to the main building around 5:30 a.m. The suspects continued to the pharmacy and smashed out another window to take prescription drugs and money from the cash register. All parties appeared to be male but were wearing mask and gloves. They fled from the area in a black SUV. The license plate was not visible on the security footage. 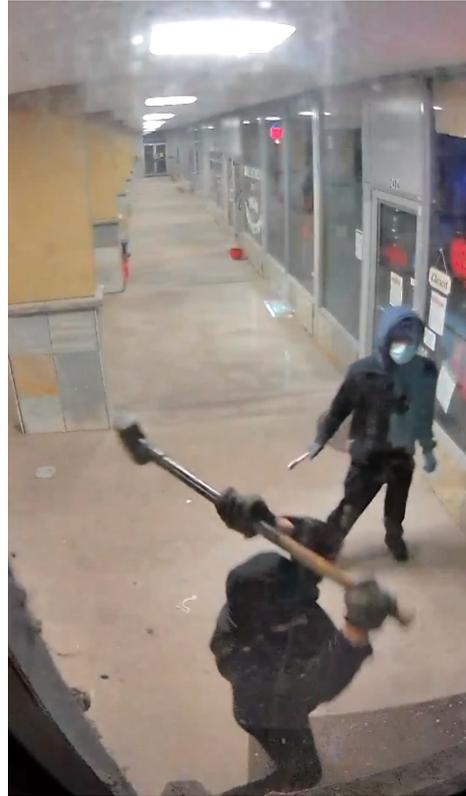
### Case Report 23-6416

On Nov. 7 at 11:50 p.m. officers were on routine patrol near the unit block of West Bridge Street, where they noticed a suspicious vehicle with no visible license plate. The vehicle was occupied by two people who appeared to be passed out. Upon contacting the occupants, officers were able to see drug paraphernalia inside the vehicle. They conducted a search of the vehicle and recovered the drug paraphernalia, 11 fentanyl pills, and a small amount of methamphetamine. Officers also recovered a handgun that had a serial number which appeared to be tampered with. Both suspects, one of which had an active warrant, were arrested and transported to Adams County jail.



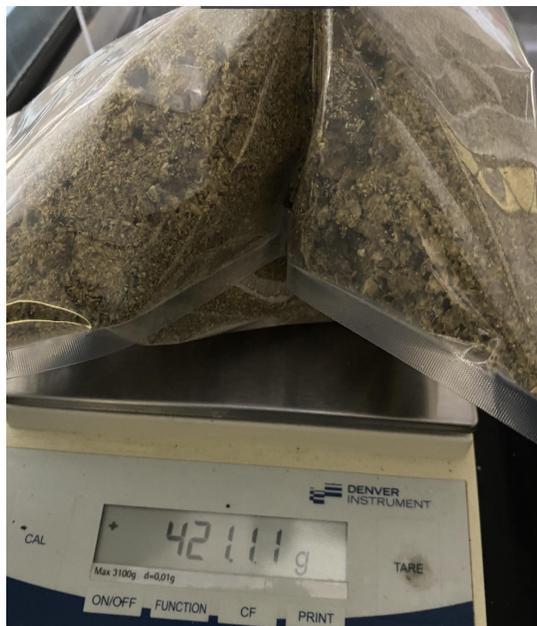
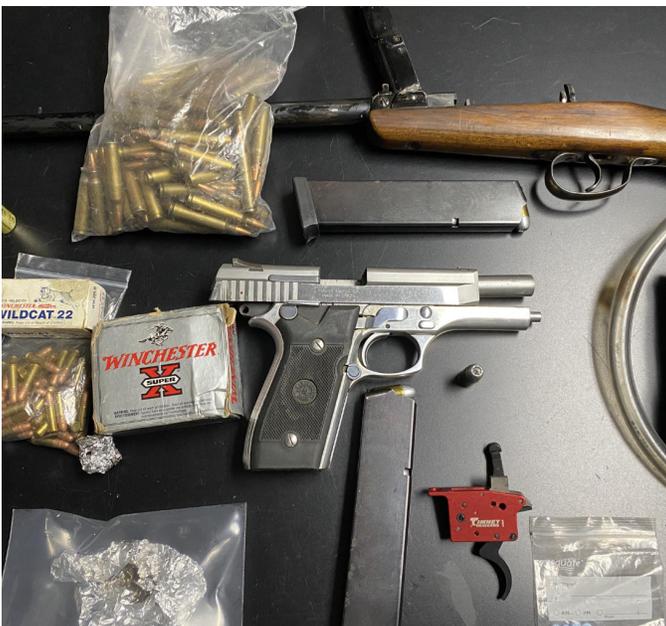
Case Report 23-6480

On Nov. 11 officers were dispatched to a glass break alarm at a liquor store in the 2400 block of East Bridge Street. An additional reporting party called in at this time and stated they witnessed an attempted burglary. They described two males dressed in all black wearing masks, who ran from the scene after hearing the alarm. A sledgehammer was left on scene, and security footage was collected from the business owner. Case Report 23-6485

On Nov. 11 at 2:20 p.m. officers were dispatched to a suspicious vehicle in the parking lot of a business. Upon arrival officers observed a single occupant who appeared to be passed out. When officers contacted and identified the individual, they learned that he had eight active warrants. Additional officers were able to see drug paraphernalia inside the vehicle, so they conducted a search. They recovered two guns, ammunition, a large amount of marijuana, and additional drug paraphernalia. The suspect was arrested and booked into Adams County jail.
