## SECTION 1

# SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

---

### Case Report 23-6524

On Nov. 13 at 2 p.m. officers were on routine patrol near County Road 2 1/2 and County Road 27 when they observed a vehicle with a malfunctioning tail light. Upon contacting the driver, officers noticed marijuana inside the vehicle. The driver informed officers that there was a gun in the center console, and that he was convicted felon. Officers also discovered additional drug paraphernalia inside the vehicle. The 45-year-old male was arrested for possession of a firearm by a previous offender, and later transported to Weld County jail.

### Case Report 23-6605

On Nov. 16 at 4 p.m. officers responded to Walmart for a report of child abuse. The reporting party stated there was a baby and two young children inside a car in the parking lot with no adult, and they had been there for over 20 minutes. The mother of the children exited the store soon after officers arrived. She was issued a court summons for child abuse.

### Case Report 23-6613

On Nov. 16 at 10:45 p.m. officers conducted a traffic stop in the 100 block of East Bromley Lane. The driver was found to have a revoked license and was in possession of 7.5 grams of fentanyl, a small amount of methamphetamine, and drug paraphernalia. The 38-year-old male was transported to Adams County jail on multiple charges.



### Case Report 23-6644

On Nov. 18 at 1 a.m. an officer was on routine patrol in the 100 block of North Main Street when he observed a speeding vehicle driving 31 miles per hour over the posted speed limit. Upon contacting the vehicle, he observed five male occupants, one of which was holding an AR-15 style rifle. Additional officers responded to assist, and they recovered an additional gun, ammunition, cocaine, marijuana, alcohol, drug paraphernalia and more. All males were between the ages of 16 and 21. Three of them were transported to Adams County jail.



#### Case Report 23-6642

On Nov. 17 just before 10 p.m. officers responded to a single motor vehicle crash in the area of Highway 85 and East 136th Avenue. The reporting party stated they saw someone walk away from the crashed vehicle toward Johnson Auto Plaza. A male matching the description was located and contacted by officers in the area. He appeared to be under the influence and denied crashing the vehicle, he was also in possession of a knife. He was uncooperative with officers and eventually taken to Adams County jail on multiple charges.


