SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 23-7089

On Dec. 14 just before 5 p.m. Brighton Police officers were conducting strategic retail theft enforcement in partnership with King Soopers on North 50th Avenue. An individual suspected of theft became combative and additional officers responded to assist. The 32-year-old male was taken into custody and was found to have two active warrants. He was transported to the hospital for medical clearance before being booked into Adams County jail.

Case Report 23-7091

On Dec. 14 around 7 p.m. officers conducted a traffic stop in the 300 block of East Bromley Lane. The adult male driver of the vehicle fled on foot and has not yet been apprehended. Officers do not believe there is any threat to the community. Officers recovered nearly 3 pounds of narcotics from the suspect vehicle. This is an active and ongoing investigation.

Case Report 23-7141


On Dec. 16 around 9:45 p.m. officers were dispatched to a robbery in progress at a gas station in the 2100 block of Barr Place. Dispatch advised that a male had entered the store and threatened the cashier if she didn't give him all the money in the safe and registers. Upon further investigation the suspect was believed to be a male between 5-foot-6 and 5-foot-10 wearing a red bandana, large gray Dickies jacket, blue jeans, brown shoes and gray gloves and was last seen walking toward I-76 (see below for photo). This is an active and ongoing investigation.

Case Report 23-7118

On Dec. 16 just before 2 a.m., officers observed a 17-year-old male running through an apartment complex who had previously run from officers that day when he shoplifted from Safeway. The male was known to have three active warrants for his arrest. Officers contacted him in the apartment hallway and he was arrested. He was transported to the hospital for medical treatment before being booked into the juvenile detention center on felony warrants and several other charges. He was found to be highly intoxicated.

Case Report 23-7147

On Dec. 17 around 10 a.m. officers were dispatched to a hotel in the 2100 block of Medical Center Drive for a cold false imprisonment report. After further investigation, a 51-year-old male was arrested for false imprisonment of a hotel staff member. The suspect was also found to be in possession of over 5 grams of fentanyl pills. He was processed and booked into Adams County jail.
