SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 23-7301

On Dec. 24 at 9:10 p.m. officers responded to the 200 block of South 14th Avenue regarding a party with a gun. Dispatch advised the suspect was threatening family members. Officers arrived in the area and found the suspect walking down South 14th Avenue and Egbert Street carrying a shotgun. The suspect immediately dropped the shotgun when approached by officers. The 25-year-old male was taken into custody without further incident. Upon further investigation, officers confirmed the suspect did not shoot at anyone but fired off three rounds outside. He was processed and booked into Adams County jail on charges of felony menacing, child abuse (no injury), weapon-prohibited use-under influence of alcohol or drugs w/ gun, and recklessly discharging a firearm.

Case Report 23-7365

At 1:07 a.m. on Dec. 28 officers were on routine patrol when they observed a female sleeping in a vehicle that was sitting at a gas pump in the 5100 block of East Bromley Lane at Kum & Go. The license plate was cleared and found to be associated with a felony warrant. Officers contacted the 33-year-old female, confirmed the warrant, and took her into custody. In plain view drug paraphernalia was seen inside of the vehicle. A search of the vehicle revealed a stolen license plate, more drug paraphernalia, and two financial cards not belonging to the suspect. She was processed and booked into Adams County jail, where a further body search revealed a tube containing over 50 blue fentanyl pills. The suspect was held at Adams County jail on unlawful possession of a controlled substance, introducing contraband, possession of drug paraphernalia, theft of license plate, criminal possession of a financial device, and a felony warrant.

Case Report 23-7375

Case Report 23-7382

At 1:57 a.m. on Dec. 29 officers conducted a traffic stop on a truck for running a red light and weaving on South 4th Avenue and East Bromley Lane. The driver, a 33-year-old male, was found to be driving under the influence with an adult female in the passenger seat and three children in the backseat. He was arrested for DUI, child abuse, obstruction and failure to obey a traffic signal. After receiving medical attention, he was processed and booked into Adams County jail.

Case Report 23-7411

On Dec. 30 at 6:48 p.m. officers were dispatched to a hit and run near U.S. Highway 85 and West Bromley Lane. The victim decided to follow the suspect vehicle where it was ditched near WCR 2 and WCR 19. Witnesses observed two males flee from the vehicle. Officers contacted the victim and gathered the information. D.E.N. Towing was able to tow the suspect vehicle to their yard. While the tow driver was leaving, he spotted the suspects and they were arrested. Great assist by our partners at D.E.N. Towing!

Case Report 23-7430

On Dec. 31 around 6:15 p.m. officers spotted an unoccupied stolen vehicle in the 2100 block of Prairie Center Parkway while conducting a directed patrol in the area. While observing the vehicle, the suspect, a 37-year-old male, returned to the vehicle and was taken into custody without incident. He was later found to have two active warrants. The suspect was booked into Adams County jail on several charges.

THIS WEEK'S CRIME PREVENTION TIP

As a firearm owner, it is your responsibility to ensure that guns in your home are stored where they are inaccessible to children or other unauthorized persons. Hiding a gun in a closet, drawer or similar location is not safe storage. Safe storage is employing precautions and multiple safeguards that provide an additional barrier against unauthorized use. Ideally, cable-style locks should be used in addition to primary storage system like a gun safe or vault. The Brighton Police Department participates in Project ChildSafe and has free gun locks available! Stop by the Police Department at 3401 E. Bromley Ln. and ask for one at the front desk.
