

SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-0364

At 1:00 a.m. on Jan. 20 officers spotted an occupied suspicious vehicle in the 800 block of Baseline Place. The driver, a 38-year-old male, was found to have an open container. Upon further searching the vehicle officers located drug paraphernalia and over 200 grams of methamphetamine, as well as a stolen handgun and several other items. The male was arrested and transported to Adams County jail.



Case Report 24-0371

At 12:55 p.m. on Jan. 20 officers were dispatched to a shoplifting at Walgreens. The suspects fled prior to officer arrival, but the reporting party was able to get a vehicle description and license plate number. At 1:33 p.m., officers located the vehicle in the 100 block of Penny Lane. When officers pulled in near the suspect vehicle they could see that it was occupied. A few moments later, the suspect attempted to start driving away. The suspect backed into a light pole before hitting the officer's patrol car, and then backed into a tree. A passenger exited the vehicle and began to run away on foot, and another passenger ran out of the back seat. The officer was quickly able to leap over the hood of his patrol car to detain the driver. The 25-year-old male driver was arrested and stolen property from Walgreens was recovered.

THIS WEEK'S CRIME PREVENTION TIP

The highest risk for having your car stolen is by compromising the basic security features of the vehicle.

- Never leave your car running unattended.
- Always keep your car doors locked, when driving or parked.
- Always park in well-lit areas.
- Don't store firearms in your car.
- Avoid leaving documents with your address in glove box. (Only keep the half of the registration slip without your address in your car.)
- If you are approached, do not roll down the windows or open a door.
- Manage your risk- buy comprehensive insurance that covers stolen vehicles. Also consider getting gap insurance.
