SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-0415

On Jan. 22 just after 6 p.m. officers responded to reports of a juvenile female pedestrian being hit by a vehicle near Egbert Street and South Kuner Road. The victim appeared to be suffering from a severe head injury and was quickly transported to the hospital. She is expected to survive. Investigators do not suspect alcohol/drugs or reckless driving and the driver stayed on scene. The driver was cited for careless driving causing injury to vulnerable road user.

Case Report 24-0436

A juvenile suspect was arrested in a drive by shooting that occurred on Jan. 23 around 11:45 p.m. in the 800 block of South 8th Avenue. No injuries were reported, and detectives believe this was an isolated incident, there is no threat to the public. This is an active investigation, and more details will be released as they become available.

Case Report 24-0477
