SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-0537

On Jan. 29 at 1:35 a.m. officers were dispatched to the area of 124th Avenue and Northbound Highway 85 regarding a wrong-way driver. After officers made several attempts to stop the driver, he finally came to a stop at 168th Avenue. The male was found to be highly intoxicated. He was arrested and booked into Adams County jail.

Case Report 24-0599


On Feb. 1 at 2:35 a.m. officers were dispatched to a hotel parking lot where someone was parking in random spots and they were not a guest of the hotel. Officers arrived and found the vehicle occupied by a male driver. The driver put the car in gear and drove toward the officer's patrol car, crashing into it. The suspect tried to back away, and then crashed into the front of the patrol vehicle again before quickly reversing and fleeing the scene. Officers had a basic description of the suspect and the license plate number. Detectives received the information the following morning and were able to locate the vehicle off of Lark Avenue. After a short foot pursuit the 29-year-old male suspect was taken into custody. He was booked into Adams County jail on multiple felony charges.

Case Report 24-0634

On Feb. 2 at 7:30 p.m., officers were dispatched to a 19-year-old female near South 18th Avenue and East Bridge Street who had been hit by a car and was on the roadway. The involved vehicle was parked in the Discount Tire parking lot and the driver had fled the scene. The driver was described as a Hispanic male, middle-aged, wearing gray basketball shorts, black shirt and a black hat. He was last seen running north on North 19th Avenue. Witnesses stated the vehicle ran a red light and hit the female while she was crossing the crosswalk. The victim suffered serious bodily injury. This crash is still under investigation.

Case Report 24-0637

On Feb. 2 at 9:55 p.m. officers heard what sounded like a crash in the area of South 20th Avenue and East Bridge Street. Officers followed the sound to a damaged vehicle that was backing into a parking block. Officers contacted the 20-year-old male driver who was found to be very intoxicated. The truck appeared to have been damaged from a crash on the front right side. After further investigation, officers located our demolished Speed/Radar trailer on East Bridge Street and Chapel Hill Drive. Officers also located a headlight left at the scene and compared it to the truck to determine that the DUI driver hit the speed trailer. The driver was arrested and booked into Adams County jail. His insurance will now have to pay for a new Radar Trailer.

THIS WEEK'S CRIME PREVENTION TIP

Vishing, also known as, "voice phishing" involves cell phone scam calls that urge you to take action — normally by calling you or leaving a voicemail. Vishing involves scammers trying to impersonate an authentic person or organization to gain your trust. They may pose as part of an official company or government service, convincing you that you must provide personal information or money. These scams usually try to get you to act during the phone call. If you suspect voice phishing, hang up immediately. Then, search for the company's official public phone number and call the organization in question.
