# SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

---

### Case Report 24-0691

On Feb. 6 around 12:30 p.m. officers conducted a traffic stop near South 27th Avenue and Southern Street where they recovered 24.36 grams of methamphetamine. The two adult male occupants were arrested and transported to Adams County jail.



### Case Report 24-0721

On Feb. 8 at 3:30 am officers were dispatched to the 100 block of West Bridge Street (Paisano Liquors) regarding several glass break alarms. Officers arrived on scene within minutes and observed the drive thru window broken out. A trail of alcohol shooters in the parking lot led towards the south of the building. No suspects were found in the area. It appeared the suspects had thrown a rock through the window and stole alcohol within reach. The store owner arrived on scene and officers viewed the surveillance footage, which showed two suspects, one male and one female, dressed in all black. The male was wearing white and black Air Jordan 11 Retro shoes. It appears both suspects left on foot southbound towards Miller Ave. The owner of the liquor store stated the two suspects had stolen several alcohol shooters.

### Case Report 24-0740

On Feb. 9 just before 2:30 a.m. officers were dispatched to a verified alarm at a liquor store located near the 100 block of West Longs Peak Street. The reporting party was a security company watching two males attempt to break into the liquor store via the drive thru. Officers quickly responded to the area and located the suspects as they attempted to flee. Officers successfully arrested both males and they were booked into Adams County jail on several charges.

### Case Report 24-0761

On Feb. 9 at 10:21 p.m. officers were dispatched to a motor vehicle theft at 1012 E Bridge St (7-11). The victim stated that he observed two males get into his truck and begin to drive away while he was in the store. The victim then ran to his stolen vehicle and attempted to open the door to grab the driver. While doing this the victim fell, hitting his head on the concrete.

Officers quickly responded to the area and observed the vehicle fleeing. Officers saw the suspect exit the vehicle and located footprints in the snow that led to a home. Officers contacted two people inside the residence who refused to identify themselves or come outside. A code red was sent for the surrounding houses to shelter in place.

Announcements from the PA were made and after approximately 1.5 hours until the homeowner allowed officers to search the home. During the search the suspect was not located. This is an active investigation.

### Case Report 24-0762

On Feb. 10 at 2:37 a.m. officers were dispatched to a crash. Firefighters and responding officers observed the driver fleeing through the truck yard of Transwest. Officers then observed the driver enter one of the unlocked semi tractors in the lot. While the officers had the semi surrounded, others at the crash site observed multiple alcohol containers. The male refused to come out of the truck and OC was sprayed inside. The 28-year-old male driver then exited the vehicle. After receiving medical attention he was booked into Adams County jail on multiple charges of criminal trespass and DUI.
