# SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

---

### Case Report 24-0800

On Feb. 12 an 86-year-old male left his home to go to the post office around 2:40 p.m. Several hours later, the family called BPD concerned for his safety as he hadn't returned home. They provided his license plate and vehicle information, so officers sent out a BOLO. Shortly after that, the male was safely located in Arvada. The family was so grateful for our help that they requested to meet the officer who helped them.



### Case Report 24-0833

On Feb. 14 at 5:41 a.m. officers were dispatched to the 2400 block of Prairie Center Parkway regarding a suspicious incident. The reporting party was arriving at work and saw two males exit a vehicle. Shortly after that, the alarm from a nearby business went off and the vehicle sped away. Officers arrived on scene and found the front glass door shattered with a large rock lying inside of the business. This is an ongoing investigation.

### Case Report 24-0866

Officers were dispatched to Johnson's Auto Plaza regarding individuals trying to break into vehicles. Officers arrived in the area and located suspects fleeing on foot towards E-470. The suspects were located and two individuals were taken into custody for 3rd Degree Trespass, Attempted 2nd degree criminal trespass, obstructions, resisting arrest, reckless endangerment, unlawful possession of a controlled substance, unlawful possession of fentanyl and drug paraphernalia.

### Case Report 24-0854

On Feb. 15 around 12:15 p.m. a disassembled firearm was found on school property at Innovations & Options. One juvenile was arrested. [Read the full news release here.](#)

#### Case Report 24-0914

On Feb. 18 around 3:30 p.m. a vehicle was called in for reckless driving on westbound I-76. At 4:50 p.m. the same vehicle was seen by officers running the red light at South 27th Avenue and East Bromley Lane. Officers observed the vehicle weaving and striking the curb and they attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The vehicle failed to yield and continued to the registered address in the 1500 block of Walnut Drive. Officers contacted the 38-year-old female driver and found her to be under the influence with her two children in the car. She was arrested on several charges and transported to Adams County jail, while victim advocates provided support for the children and notified CPS.

#### Case Report 24-0903

On Feb. 18 just before 2:45 a.m. officers responded to an armed carjacking in the 300 block of North 12th Avenue. This is an ongoing investigation.

#### Case Report 24-0907

On the morning of Feb. 18 officers were dispatched to a cold burglary at Main Street Café. Through further investigation they determined that a 51-year-old male had stolen several items from the business. Officers had contacted the same male earlier that morning, so they were able to quickly locate him. The male initially tried to run from officers but was taken into custody without incident. He received medical attention before being processed and transported to Adams County jail on several charges.
