SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-0934

The Brighton Police Department, in partnership with FBI Rocky Mountain Safe Streets Task Force, arrested 56-year-old John Kirby on Feb. 22 in connection with the robbery of TBK Bank on Feb. 6 and Bank of Colorado on Feb. 19.

Case Report 24-0923

On Feb. 19 just before 12:45 a.m. officers were dispatched to the area of North 11th Avenue and Myrtle Street regarding a male rummaging through vehicles. The reporting party gave a description of the male and the last seen location. Officers arrived in the area and successfully located and identified the suspect. He was found to be in possession of multiple wallets, driver's licenses, debit cards, and drug paraphernalia. The 52-year-old male was arrested and booked into Adams County jail on several charges and warrants.

Case Report 24-0993

On Feb. 22 officers were dispatched to a disturbance with weapons in the 3000 block of East Bridge Street after receiving reports that there was an armed male walking around making threats. Upon arrival, officers witnessed a male walk out of a unit with a rifle and walk into a shed. Officers gave commands and he eventually complied. The male was transported for a mental health evaluation.

Case Report 24-1028

On Feb. 23 officers were dispatched to Walmart in reference to multiple reports of a male waving a gun in the parking lot who was possibly walking into the store. When officers arrived, the suspect drove away. Officers successfully located the vehicle and stopped it at South 4th Avenue and Southern Street. After a high risk stop, the officers identified the suspect and began investigating the incident. Officers learned that a road rage had escalated in the parking lot of Walmart. When the confrontation escalated, the suspect pulled out a gun and displayed it at the victim. Through further investigation officers discovered a loaded and assembled handgun in the suspect's vehicle. The 19-year-old male was arrested on multiple charges and booked into Adams County jail.

Case Report 24-1029

On Feb. 23 near the 1500 block of East Bridge Street officers responded to an auto-pedestrian crash just before 7:30 p.m. An 82-year-old male was hit while crossing East Bridge Street and he was quickly transported to the hospital. The driver remained on scene and officers do not believe they were speeding or driving impaired. This is an ongoing investigation.
