# **SIGNIFICANT EVENTS**

---

### Case Report 24-1076

On Feb. 26 just before 2 p.m. officers received reports that a 77-year-old male with dementia had jumped out of his wife's vehicle at Lowes and ran away. After searching for two hours, he was successfully located about a mile away with the help of a community member.

### Case Report 24-1138

On Feb. 29 at 11:19 p.m., Brighton officers were notified of another agency in the area of East 168th Avenue and North 7th Avenue who were conducting a high risk stop on a suspect vehicle. The other agency advised the suspects were involved in a felony menacing and shooting in their town and that the vehicle was occupied by four people. Brighton responded and assisted with transporting several suspects.

### Case Report 24-1166

At 11:36 a.m. on March 2 officers were dispatched to a vehicle on fire in the area of Interstate 76 and Sable Boulevard. They were advised it was catching the nearby field on fire as well. Officers arrived and shut down westbound traffic so the fire department could put out both fires. No injuries were reported, and the driver stated she was driving her 2005 Honda Accord on Interstate 76 when her power steering went out. She pulled over and that's when the engine compartment caught on fire. A portion of the highway was closed for about an hour and a half for clean up.

### Case Report 24-1175

Officers were dispatched to a report of two infant children wandering around near Highway 85, by the Motel 6. These children were partially clothed and close enough to traffic that there were two separate people who called in to report their concern. A third driver stopped to try and get the children out of the road as officers arrived. The two children were under the age of 5, and a third infant was inside a room at Motel 85. The children's mother approached officers and advised them that the kids routinely do this despite her efforts to keep them from doing so. The mother was found to have an outstanding warrant for her arrest, and she was arrested and charged with two counts of child abuse.

**THIS WEEK'S CRIME PREVENTION TIP**

As a firearm owner, it is your responsibility to ensure that guns in your home are stored where they are inaccessible to children or other unauthorized persons. Hiding a gun in a closet, drawer or similar location is not safe storage. Safe storage is employing precautions and multiple safeguards that provide an additional barrier against unauthorized use. Ideally, cable-style locks should be used in addition to primary storage system like a gun safe or vault.
