
SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-1386

Around 2 p.m. on March 13 officers were dispatched to a robbery that had just occurred at Brighton Village Senior Apartments. Officers contacted the 84-year-old female victim who stated she was assaulted and robbed in the parking lot. She reported that her bracelet and ring were taken from her hands. This is an ongoing investigation.

Case Report 24-1393

On March 13 around 5:15 p.m., officers were dispatched to the Prairie Center area for three people who were reportedly ducking behind the electrical boxes wearing masks and carrying backpacks. Upon arrival the suspects ran off. Two of the three suspects were caught by officers and held for questioning. One of the suspects, a 34-year-old male, then escaped from officers and got away. The other suspect, another 34-year-old male, was found to be in possession of 1.14 grams of powdered Fentanyl. He was also in possession of cutting tools used to break security features on high valued items. This is an ongoing investigation.



Case Report 24-1398

At 7:18 p.m. on March 13, officers were dispatched to check on a 66-year-old female, who was diagnosed as Type 1 Diabetic and her daughter hadn't heard from her. An officer arrived and was able to see a female slumped over inside the home who was unresponsive. The officer made the quick decision to make entry and render her aid. She was then transported to the hospital. The officer's actions likely saved her life.

Case Report 24-1422

At 6:42 a.m. on March 15, officers were dispatched to a residential smoke alarm. Shortly after this, additional calls were received about shots fired in the area. Upon arrival, officers could smell gun powder and heard multiple shots coming from inside the home. Nearby residents received a CodeRed emergency alert, and they were quickly evacuated. Crisis negotiators and SWAT responded to the scene, where they successfully got the 51-year-old male suspect to surrender. The male was later taken to Adams County jail on multiple weapons charges and reckless endangerment. The District Attorney's Office accepted the charges on March 20.

Case Report 24-1440

Around 6:45 a.m. on March 16, officers were dispatched to a CPR in progress. Upon arrival, they discovered a family fight had escalated. An adult female had knife injuries and another adult male was deceased. Detectives are continuing to investigate the incident.

Case Report 24-1454

At 7:18 p.m. on March 16, officers were dispatched to several alarms at Henderson Elementary. The building was cleared with the help of K9 from ACSO. Video surveillance obtained after the incident showed that two suspects fled from the opposite side of the building when officers arrived. A further investigation revealed significant damage to the inside of the school. This is an ongoing investigation.

St. Patrick's Day DUI Saturation

BPD officers, along with several other agencies, participated in a DUI saturation on Saturday night. They were looking for drivers who were impaired or under the influence. 55 cops participated in total, 365 traffic stops were conducted, and 24 DUI arrests were made. Our very own Brighton Police officers also recovered 13 grams of fentanyl and had a significant DUI arrest that included speeding 30+ mph over the limit, driving without a license, and three counts of child abuse.
