# SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

---

### Case Report 24-1637

On March 25 around 10 p.m. officers were dispatched to Walmart regarding a shoplift in progress. When officers arrived on scene they observed a male matching the suspect description near the produce section. The male attempted to walk away from officers as he was pulling concealed items out from underneath his jacket, but they successfully stopped him without incident. A further search revealed that he was in possession of a large amount of money, 63 fentanyl pills, 1.14g of Methamphetamine, clear baggies, pistol ammo, and multiple drug paraphernalia items. He had also concealed merchandise from the store. The 32-year-old male was arrested and transported to Adams County jail.

### Case Report 24-1758

On March 31 at 4:45 p.m. officers were dispatched to a felony menacing in progress in the area of West Bromley Lane and Highway 85. The victims reported a passenger in another car pulled out a gun and pointed it at them. Officers were able to find the suspect vehicle and conduct a traffic stop at 136th Avenue. Officers detained the driver and passenger of the suspect vehicle and located a firearm inside the vehicle. The victims in the case did not want to pursue charges.
