SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-1767

On April 1 around 7:15 a.m. officers responded to a report of a protection order violation. The suspect began following the victim in a vehicle throughout the city. Officers located the suspect vehicle and initiated a traffic stop. The suspect barricaded himself in his vehicle, so a vehicle pinch was performed and a high-risk stop was initiated. The 45-year-old male was arrested for several charges including violation of a protection order, domestic violence, and driving under the influence.



Case Report 24-1833

At 8:36 a.m. on April 4, officers were dispatched to an incident where a 30-year-old male was attacking his mother with a screwdriver. The male was found to be under the influence of drugs. He was arrested and booked into Adams County jail on charges of assault, menacing, possession of controlled substance and paraphernalia.

Case Report 24-1861

On April 5 just before 2 a.m. officers were on routine patrol in the area of South Kuner Road and West Southern Street when they observed a vehicle with expired tags. They conducted a traffic stop and a probable cause search yielded over 12 grams of methamphetamine, drug paraphernalia, and three guns. The driver, who was found to have active warrants for his arrest, was arrested and transported to Adams County jail.




Case Report 24-1874

At 4:05 a.m. on April 6, officers were dispatched to a disturbance with weapons. Officers were informed that multiple people were fighting and one had produced a gun and was actively fleeing in a truck. Officers arrived quickly and conducted a high-risk stop of the truck. Through further investigation it was discovered that the driver, a 21-year-old male, had an argument and displayed a gun. He was arrested and booked into Adams County jail.

Case Report 24-1873

At 3:30 a.m. on April 6, officers were on routine patrol when they conducted a traffic stop. The driver, a 35-year-old female, was acting strangely and attempting to conceal drug paraphernalia. A search yielded 6 grams of methamphetamine and 64 fentanyl pills. The suspect was arrested and booked into Adams County jail.

THIS WEEK'S SAFETY TIP

Spring is here! We want to remind you to test your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors. If the alarm makes a "chirping" sound, replace the battery immediately. Smoke alarms should be in every bedroom and in the common areas on each floor of a home. Mount them at least 10 feet from the stove to reduce false alarms, less than 12 inches from the ceiling and away from windows, doors and ducts. The safety tips for CO detectors mirror those of smoke alarms: change the batteries, test them and interconnect them, if possible. Also, make sure vents for your gas appliances (fireplace, dryer, stove and furnace) are free and clear of debris.
