# SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

### Case Report 24-1957

On April 10 at 10:40 a.m. officers located a stolen vehicle in the Walmart parking lot. The vehicle was found to be occupied by someone sleeping in the back seat. The suspect was given verbal commands to exit the vehicle and she complied. The 28-year-old female had several active warrants. She was booked and processed into Adams County jail.

### Case Report 24-2006

At 4:10 p.m. on April 12, an officer was dispatched to a male having a heart attack at Mayeda Park. The male was unresponsive and not breathing. The officer performed CPR for about 5 minutes until medical personnel arrived and took over. The 54-year-old male regained consciousness and was transported to the hospital.

### Case Report 24-2033

On April 13 just before 5:30 p.m. officers responded to the 200 block of Denver Street for a report of a burglary. The homeowner was not home and reported that no one else should be there. Upon arrival, officers observed the front door to be ajar. They gave verbal commands for anyone inside to exit the residence, and the 31-year-old male suspect exited and surrendered. He was booked and processed into Adams County jail for burglary.
