SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-2132

On April 18 officers were dispatched to take a report of a domestic violence incident. Patrol officers conducted the initial investigation and notified detectives about the case, since the suspect was still at-large. Later that day, detectives successfully located and arrested the suspect without incident. They also recovered a firearm from the scene. The 25-year-old male was arrested and booked into Adams County jail on charges of domestic violence, felony menacing, and child abuse.

Case Report 24-2071

On April 15 just after 4 p.m. an off-duty officer called to report a group of juveniles shooting pedestrians with an Orbeez gun from a moving vehicle. Officers arrived in the area and located the suspect vehicle at Benedict Park. After a further investigation, two juveniles were released on scene with a summons. One 16-year-old male was arrested after a search of the vehicle yielded a defaced handgun and an open alcohol container.
