SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

On May 15, charges were presented to the 17th Judicial District Attorney's office in reference to the Amber Alert issued by the Brighton Police Department on May 4. Six felony counts of violation of a custody order were accepted against the suspect, Justena Tomasino. Under Colorado laws, the arrest and filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.

Case Report 24-2580

On May 10 the Brighton/Commerce City SWAT team was deployed to arrest a suspect with several felony warrants, 50-year-old Robert Trujillo, who [injured a Brighton Police Officer in August of 2023](#). When Trujillo was arrested last year he posted bail, and then failed to appear in court resulting in a warrant for his arrest. SWAT negotiators spoke with the suspect, and he surrendered peacefully. He was booked into Adams County jail for multiple felony warrants. Under Colorado laws, the arrest and filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.

Case Report 24-2605

At 7:31 p.m. on May 11, officers were dispatched to a female in a vehicle who was slumped over the steering wheel near the 2000 block of Prairie Center Parkway. The driver was contacted and detained, and a bag of over 100 blue fentanyl pills was clearly visible. The 30-year-old female was found to have multiple warrants and protection orders. She was processed and booked into Adams County jail.

Case Report 24-2583/86

At 2:41 p.m. on May 10, SROs received a report of a person with a gun near Prairie View High School. The SROs responded quickly and secured the area to protect the students. Upon arrival, officers did not find any ongoing threat. The initial investigation led officers to believe that the reported suspect(s) had left the area. This is an active and ongoing investigation, and officers have successfully identified the suspect(s).
