SECTION 1

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-2900

On May 25 at about 10:30 p.m. officers were dispatched to shots fired near the area of South 6th Avenue and Jessup Street. The reporting party advised she heard 4-8 shots near the alley. Through the initial investigation, witness statements, and surveillance footage, officers were able to identify a suspect. Thankfully, no one was injured. This case is actively being investigated,

Case Report 24-2875

On May 24 at approximately 3:30 p.m. officers were dispatched to a home on South 2nd Avenue on the report of an unconscious male. Upon arrival, officers located a 38-year-old male unresponsive on the hallway floor. Officers and medics attempted life saving efforts, however, the male was later pronounced dead. During the investigation in plain view on the bathroom sink was a small piece of aluminum foil with a half-burnt fentanyl pill and a glass pipe right next to it.

Case Report 24-2822

On May 21 officers were dispatched to Kohls, 2425 Prairie Center Parkway, on a report of a shoplifting in progress involving a male and female. The officers were able to successfully locate and arrest both suspects. The officers also found the car they came in, which was stolen out of Federal Heights.

Case Report 24-2830

On May 21 officers dispatched to a home on Dogwood Avenue regarding an overdose. The reporting party stated there was an unresponsive 70-year-old male and that CPR was in progress. Officers arrived on scene and found a male not breathing and lying on the floor in the living room. Life saving measures were not successful. Several pills (Oxy), and other drug paraphernalia were found near the deceased.
