SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

This week the police department responded to assist Brighton Fire Rescue with approximately five different fires where the initial investigation revealed fireworks to be the cause. Brighton Police Department wants to remind residents that fireworks that leave the ground are illegal in the City of Brighton. Fortunately, everyone was safely evacuated and there were no injuries reported.

Illegally and improperly disposed fireworks can cause serious injury or death. Several of the fires this week were believed to be started by fireworks being disposed in trash cans. Please be mindful and make safety a priority when celebrating.

Case Report 24-3691

On July 3 at 5:10 p.m. officers were dispatched to a crash at East Bridge Street and Mt. Bierstadt Street. The initial investigation revealed that a vehicle traveling westbound on East Bridge Street at a high rate of speed had collided with another vehicle that entered the intersection. The impact caused the second vehicle to careen into a light pole, knocking it down and trapping the driver inside. The driver had to be extricated from her vehicle but was uninjured. The at-fault driver, a 37-year-old male, was found to be driving under the influence. He was arrested and transported to Adams County jail.

Case Report 24-3758

Just after 11:45 a.m. on July 6, officers were on routine patrol at Windmill Ranch Apartments when they observed a suspicious van with a flat tire. After clearing the license plate officers discovered that the vehicle was reported stolen. Great proactive work by our officers!
