SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-4387

On Aug. 5 just before 1 p.m. officers were dispatched to a report of suspicious activity at Home Depot. Staff witnessed a suspect shoplift over \$4,000 worth of merchandise, and they were able to point out the suspect's vehicle which was still on scene and occupied. Officers successfully contacted and arrested the 21-year-old male, and later learned that he had also stolen thousands of dollars worth of merchandise from another store in Lakewood. This is an ongoing investigation.

Case Report 24-4420

On Aug. 7 around 7:30 a.m. patrol officers were sent to the intersection of Telluride Street and Bridge Street for a crash involving a Toyota sedan and a Hyundai sedan. The driver of the Toyota was heading westbound on Bridge Street and failed to stop at the red light at Telluride. The Hyundai was traveling southbound on Telluride through the intersection when it was hit by the Toyota. The driver of the Hyundai, a 46-year-old woman from Brighton, sustained a severe laceration from the crash. The driver of the Toyota, a 20-year-old woman from Thornton, was suspected of being under the influence of alcohol and was subsequently arrested and booked into the Adams County Jail on the charge of Vehicular Assault.

Case Report 24-4432

On Aug. 7 at 2:45 p.m., patrol officers were dispatched to the 500 block of North Main Street for a crash involving a motorcycle and an SUV. The motorcycle was traveling northbound on Main Street, and the SUV was traveling southbound, making a left-hand turn into a business parking lot on Main Street. The SUV turned in front of the motorcycle, causing a collision. The motorcyclist was not wearing a helmet and sustained a severe head injury and internal injuries from the crash. The driver of the SUV was arrested on suspicion of being under the influence of drugs and was later booked into jail on the charge of vehicular assault. The motorcyclist is a 43-year-old male from Brighton, and the SUV driver is a 49-year-old male from Brighton.

Case Report 24-4471

At 1:57 p.m. on Aug. 9, officers were dispatched to a protection order violation. When officers arrived, the suspect was causing an active disturbance and being uncooperative. The suspect began spitting at officers and trying to punch them. They were able to safely place her into handcuffs. The 22-year-old female was taken directly to Adams County jail. She was booked in with multiple charges including Assault on a Peace Officer.

Case Report 24-4478

At 7:49 p.m. on Aug. 9 officers were dispatched to a hit and run crash involving a motorcycle. A 46-year-old male was riding his motorcycle westbound on East 168th Avenue and slowing to turn right on WCR 31. A male driving a silver Chevrolet Cruze rear-ended the motorcycle causing the motorcyclist to be thrown. The vehicle fled the scene and the motorcyclist sustained serious injuries. Officers were able to get a license plate for the suspect vehicle. This is an ongoing investigation.

Case Report 24-4497

On Aug. 10 at 9:04 p.m., officers were dispatched to a suspicious vehicle in the 4300 block of Mt. Harvard Street that was later determined to be a stolen vehicle. Officers were then dispatched to multiple different addresses in the same neighborhood involving a male throwing rocks at homes and running through backyards. The suspect was later located sleeping in a backyard. He was taken into custody and found to be in possession of meth. The 39-year-old male is suspected of being involved with the recovered stolen vehicle, and this is an active and ongoing investigation.
