### **SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS**

#### Case Report 24-4544

On Aug. 12 officers responded to Kohl's for a male party attempting to break into vehicles. Officers were informed the male party went running into the store. When they arrived on scene, they observed the male coming out of the store and gave him verbal commands to stop. The suspect failed to stop and took off running. Officers initiated a foot pursuit and were able to successfully take the suspect into custody. The 31-year-old male was found to have a felony warrant. He was processed and booked into Adams County jail.

#### Case Report 24-3837

On Aug. 14 the Investigations Division successfully apprehended an 18-year-old suspect who was wanted for several charges including violation of a protection order and unlawful conduct involving an unserialized firearm (ghost gun). This same suspect has already been convicted in one armed robbery and is suspected in another.

#### Case Report 24-4616

At 9:03 p.m. on Aug. 15, officers were dispatched to a van that rolled over and one person was seriously injured. Officers found that a 21-year-old male was driving under the influence. He failed to negotiate the ramp and rolled into the ditch. The van was filled with tools and his passenger, a 20-year-old male, received serious injuries. The driver was booked into Adams County jail for Vehicular Assault among other charges.

#### Case Report 24-4645

At 3:26 p.m. on Aug. 17, officers were dispatched to a 1-month-old baby who was not conscious and not breathing. Officers quickly arrived on scene and started CPR until medics arrived and transported the baby to the hospital. This is an active and ongoing investigation.
