## **SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS**

### Case Report 24-4898


8:24 a.m. on Aug. 28, officers responded to an RV on fire that was spreading to a house in the 2200 block of Skeel Street. Officers were able to assist by evacuating several residents in the area. The cause of the fire is under investigation by Brighton Fire Rescue.

### Case Report 24-4897

On the morning of Aug. 28 officers responded to an injury crash near East 120th Avenue and Sable Boulevard involving four vehicles. The initial investigation reveals that one vehicle failed to stop and rearended another vehicle, which caused the next vehicle to be rearended along with the vehicle in front of it. 10 people were assessed for injuries and two were transported to the hospital.

### Case Report 24-4974

On Sept. 1 at 1:40 a.m. officers contacted a male who was in a vehicle parked facing the wrong direction in the area of South 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Laurel Street. Officers observed drug paraphernalia in the vehicle and asked the occupant to step outside. The suspect refused, so officers broke the window and opened the door to place the suspect into custody. The 44-year-old-male was found to have several active warrants. A search of the vehicle yielded 89 blue fentanyl pills and 2 grams of fentanyl powder that was prepackaged for distribution, along with other narcotics. The suspect was arrested and booked into Adams County jail.



Case Report 24-4987

On Sept. 1 just after 4:30 p.m. officers were dispatched to a shoplifting in the 2400 block of Prairie Center Parkway. When officers contacted the described male and female, they both ran away. Officers caught both suspects and placed them under arrest. They were found to be in possession of drug paraphernalia and fentanyl, and they had stolen approximately \$1200 of merchandise from Kohls. Both suspects gave false names upon arrest but were correctly identified prior to being booked into jail.
