SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-5586

At 6:07 p.m. on Sept. 25, officers were dispatched to a felony menacing in the unit block of South Miller Avenue at an apartment complex. A 41-year-old male reportedly pulled out a gun and threatened to shoot a 43-year-old male. The suspect struck the male on the head with the gun before fleeing in a vehicle. Officers quickly located the suspect and conducted a high-risk traffic stop. The suspect was arrested, and a BB gun that looks like a handgun was discovered in the suspect's vehicle. He was booked into Adams County jail on several charges. The case was filed with the 17th Judicial District Attorney's Office where they accepted the following charges:

COUNT 1: ASSAULT IN THE SECOND DEGREE, C.R.S. 18-3-203(1)(b) (F4){0202L}
COUNT 2: MENACING, C.R.S. 18-3-206 (F5){02055}

Case Report 24-5279

Community Service Officers, in partnership with investigators, responded to a community complaint in the 4300 block of Mt. Sneffels Street. There they identified a probable hoarding situation. With the help of the Colorado Bureau of Animal Protection, Colorado Humane, Denver Dumb Friends League, and Riverdale Animal Shelter, a search warrant was executed at that location. 16 adult cats, two kittens, and six dogs were removed from the residence. This is an active and ongoing investigation.
