

### **SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS**

#### Case Report 24-5687

On Sept. 30, shortly after 1:30 p.m., officers conducted a traffic stop on a motorhome without license plates near the 100 block of South 22nd Avenue. During the stop, one of the passengers was found to have multiple active warrants, and officers observed drug paraphernalia in plain view. A search of the motorhome uncovered approximately 1/4 pound of marijuana and a stolen handgun. The 62-year-old male driver and 35-year-old female passenger were arrested and transported to the Adams County Jail.



#### Case Report 24-5703

On Oct. 1 at 6:50 a.m., officers responded to the area of Swan Avenue and Hummingbird Circle following reports of a vehicle in a pond. Upon arrival, officers discovered the unoccupied vehicle, which they recognized as having eluded them twice the previous night. The vehicle was towed, and

an inventory search uncovered over 713 grams of psilocybin mushrooms. A suspect has been identified, and the investigation is ongoing.



#### Case Report 24-5716

On Oct. 1 officers observed a rider and passenger on a motorcycle with no plates. When contacted, there was an obvious burnt, meth odor on the rider. Adams County K9 responded to assist, and the dog alerted on the rider's backpack where a stolen handgun and 1.4 grams on meth were located. The driver was arrested and taken to Adams County jail. 

#### Case Report 24-5731

On Oct. 2 officers were advised of a stolen vehicle near the 4200 block of East Bromley Lane. They quickly located the vehicle at an apartment complex and attempted to deploy stop sticks, but the driver and female passenger were able to leave. Detectives followed the vehicle a short distance until they saw the two occupants ditch the car and attempt to flee on foot. Both were quickly captured and taken into custody without incident. A search of the passenger's bag recovered over 10 grams of meth, drug paraphernalia, several checks and credit cards with different names, and more. The driver, a 29-year-old male, was found to have an active warrant for robbery. He was

booked into Adams County jail. The 17-year-old female passenger was released to her parents.



Case Report 24-5791

The Brighton Police Department Traffic Safety Unit (TSU) is investigating a hit-and-run auto-pedestrian crash that resulted in serious injuries. Investigators are seeking help from the public to identify the suspect, who is believed to have been driving a 2000 Honda Civic, possibly black in color.
