SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-5861

The Brighton Police Department Traffic Safety Unit (TSU) is investigating a fatal auto-pedestrian crash that occurred on Oct. 8, just before 5 a.m. [Read the full news release on our website.](#)

Case Report 24-5876

On Oct. 8 around 3:30 p.m., officers responded to a felony menacing in progress near the 800 block of Kuner Road. Officers contacted three teenage males who were in a verbal and physical altercation with other parties. During the altercation, a 19-year-old male threatened to shoot the victim while reaching into his backpack acting like he was grabbing a gun. The 19-year-old was arrested on felony menacing charges and transported to Adams County jail. The other two males were issued summons regarding their involvement. On Oct. 11, the case was presented to the 17th Judicial District Attorney's Office, where the following charges were accepted:

COUNT 1: DISORDERLY CONDUCT, C.R.S. 18-9-106(1)(f) (M2) {2705E}

COUNT 2: CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT ASSAULT IN THE THIRD DEGREE, C.R.S. 18-3-204(1)(a);18-2-101 (M2) {02038A}

COUNT 3: DISORDERLY CONDUCT, C.R.S. 18-9-106(1)(a) (PO){2705A}

Case Report 24-5910

Around 8:40 p.m. on Oct. 9 officers received information that an adult male had assaulted his wife and put a gun in her mouth. The male left in his vehicle prior to officer arrival. The victim confirmed her husband had assaulted and strangled her, and that four children were present in the home when this occurred. Officers quickly began searching for the suspect who was taken into custody just before 11:30 p.m. He was booked into Adams County jail on several charges.

Case Report 24-5935

On Oct. 11 around 10 a.m. officers were dispatched to BJAA park where a community member reported seeing a suspicious vehicle in the parking lot. The caller advised that there was a male dressed in all black placing items near the vehicle on the sidewalk. Upon arrival, officers learned that the vehicle was a reported steal and that the driver had multiple warrants for his arrest. The suspect was taken into custody and transported to Adams County jail. On Oct. 16, this case was filed with the 17th Judicial District Attorney's Office. The following charges were accepted:

COUNT 1: MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT IN THE SECOND DEGREE, C.R.S. 18-4-409(3) (F4){0804P}

COUNT 2: THEFT, C.R.S. 18-4-401(1),(2)(b) (PO){08A1B}

COUNT 3: POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA, C.R.S. 18-18-428(1) (DPO){33466}

COUNT 4: DISPLAYING FICTITIOUS OR ALTERED LICENSE PLATES, C.R.S. 42-3-121(1)(b) (T2){72292}
