### **SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS**

#### Case Report 24-6143

On Oct. 22 just after 8:15 a.m. officers were dispatched to the area of South 34<sup>th</sup> Court and Southern Street for an injury crash where a person on an electric scooter was hit by a vehicle. The 13-year-old who was riding the scooter was transported to the hospital with serious injuries. He was not wearing a helmet. The 16-year-old driver of the vehicle was issued a court summons. Speed or impairment are not believed to be contributing factors.

#### Case Report 24-6150

On Oct. 22 officers were dispatched to an injury crash on Highway 85 and County Road 2 where a semi truck traveling northbound ran a red light and crashed into another vehicle. One person was transported to the hospital, and the roads were closed while officers investigated the crash. The driver of the semi truck was issued a summons for careless driving causing injury and failure to stop at a red light.

#### Case Report 24-6144, 6148

Brighton Police are investigating a series of vehicle trespasses that took place overnight between Oct. 21 and Oct. 22 in the area between North 5th Avenue and North 9th Avenue. Officers also received reports of similar activity between Dogwood Avenue and Birch Avenue. Residential security footage captured multiple suspects carrying weapons as they broke into several vehicles. In the footage, the suspects were also seen discharging their firearms. Fortunately, no injuries were reported. The suspects are believed to be juveniles, and an image of one individual is provided below.

Residents are reminded to lock their vehicles and park in well-lit areas. If criminal activity is observed, call 911 immediately to report it and do not attempt to confront the suspect on your own.



#### Case Report 24-6163

At 12:05 a.m. on Oct. 23, officers were dispatched to business alarm at a gas station located on County Road 27. Officers quickly arrived while the suspect was still on scene. The 21-year-old male suspect had broken the windows and was stealing merchandise. Officers were able to contact the suspect and place him into custody, even though he tried to flee. He was later booked into Weld County jail for burglary and criminal mischief.

#### Case Report 24-6205

At 4:47 p.m. on Oct. 24, officers were dispatched to a 16-year-old boy who was bleeding from the face. Officers found the teen and he said he was hit by a white car around Jessup Street and South 5th Avenue. Officers responded to the area and were later contacted by a 36-year-old male who admitted to hitting the boy with his vehicle. The suspect had a revoked license and had left the scene for 30 minutes before returning. The victim was transported to the hospital where it was determined he received serious bodily injury. The driver was arrested and later booked into Adams County jail for leaving the scene of a crash involving serious injury, careless driving causing injury, and driving revoked. The case was presented to the District Attorney's Office and they accepted the following charges:

Count 1: Leaving the scene of an accident, C.R.S. 42-4-1601(1),(2)(b)

Count 2: Infliction of serious bodily injury to a vulnerable road user, C.R.S. 42-4-1402.5; 42-4-1402

Count 3: Aggravated driving after revocation prohibited, C.R.S. 42-2-206(1)(b)

#### Case Report 24-6197

At 1:52 p.m. on Oct. 24, officers were conducting traffic enforcement in the Bridge Street construction zone when a GMC Yukon was seen traveling 43 mph in a 25 mph zone. The officer conducted a traffic stop and the 37-year-old male driver was found to be under the influence of alcohol, his license was revoked, and he had no insurance and two active warrants. He was arrested and transported to Adams County jail.
