### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

The 17th Judicial District Critical Incident Response Team (CIRT) has been activated to investigate a use of force incident involving a Brighton Police officer that resulted in serious bodily injury to a 33-year-old male suspected of assault and domestic violence. The Brighton Police Department has identified a suspect in the Oct. 4 hit-and-run auto-pedestrian crash that resulted in serious injuries. Lazaro Maya, 35, turned himself in on Nov. 4. [Read the full news release here.](#)

The Brighton Police Department has filed a felony animal cruelty case with the 17th Judicial District Attorney's Office, resulting in charges against 32-year-old Jose Gordillo. [Read the full news release here.](#)

#### Case Report 24-6359

On Oct. 31 just after 10 p.m. officers were dispatched to the 400 block of North 5th Avenue. The caller reported that there was a motorcycle parked nearby and possibly three people looking into vehicles. Officers quickly located and contacted the suspects and learned that one of them, a 41-year-old male, had an active felony warrant. The involved motorcycle was also found to be stolen out of Parker.

#### Case Report 24-6416

On Nov. 3, around 1:45 a.m., officers were dispatched to a vehicle trespass in progress at the Motel 6 on Brighton Road. The caller reported that someone was attempting to break into his truck and had pointed a gun at him. The suspects, described as two Hispanic males, fled the area before officers arrived.

This investigation remains ongoing. The Brighton Police Department reminds residents to call the police immediately in similar situations and to avoid confronting suspects directly.

#### Case Report 24-6428

On Nov. 3 around 5:30 p.m. a 40-year-old male attempted to steal a USPS mail truck. Officers arrived quickly and arrested the suspect on several charges including motor vehicle theft, impersonating a

public servant, violation of a protection order, and possession of drugs. The suspect also had multiple active warrants.
