### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

On Nov. 12, District Attorney Brian Mason [announced the First-Degree Murder conviction](#) of Ricardo Perales-Cordero, 33, following a multi-week jury trial in Adams County District Court. The homicide occurred in Brighton in October 2022. After a lengthy trial, the jury delivered a guilty verdict in less than two hours.

The Brighton Police Department commends the exceptional work of its team members across multiple divisions, whose efforts were instrumental in securing this conviction. Perales-Cordero was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole, as mandated by Colorado law.

#### Case Report 24-6569

On Nov. 9 at 9:20 p.m., officers were dispatched to a report of shots fired near the 100 block of West Bridge Street. Upon arrival, they contacted a man staying in a camper on the property. He told officers he fired shots through his camper because he believed people were outside.

To ensure public safety, officers issued a shelter-in-place order for the surrounding area and asked the man to exit his camper. The suspect complied and was taken into custody without incident. During a protective sweep of the camper, officers located the firearm and several shell casings.

A search of the area revealed no victims or any of the suspicious individuals the man had described. The 65-year-old suspect was booked into the Adams County Jail for unlawful discharge of a firearm within city limits.

#### Case Report 24-6573

On Nov. 10, officers responded to the 2100 block of Farmstead Street for a reported burglary in progress at a construction site. Real-time security surveillance showed two males forcing entry into Conex boxes and stealing property. Two vehicles were also reported to be associated with the suspects.

When officers arrived, they apprehended one suspect, a 24-year-old male, at the scene. The second suspect, also 24 years old, fled the area in a Jeep at a high rate of speed. While trying to escape, he briefly stopped and appeared to point a firearm at them before speeding away again. Officers

attempted a traffic stop, but the driver refused to comply, leading to a short pursuit that was eventually terminated.

Both vehicles involved were later determined to be stolen. The first suspect was booked into the Adams County Jail on multiple charges, including burglary and motor vehicle theft.

The second suspect, who was out on bail for attempted murder and other serious charges, was identified and located by officers on Nov. 13. He was arrested and booked into the Adams County Jail on numerous charges, including felony menacing, motor vehicle theft, burglary, and vehicular eluding.

#### Case Report 24-6584

On Nov. 10, just before 10 p.m., officers attempted a traffic stop near South 4th Avenue and West Bromley Lane. The suspect vehicle accelerated, veered into the median, and struck a traffic sign before fleeing southbound on Highway 85.

The vehicle was later spotted traveling slowly near 136th Avenue. Officers performed a vehicle pin maneuver, successfully bringing it to a stop. A high-risk traffic stop was conducted, and the driver, a 31-year-old male, was taken into custody.

The suspect was found to be intoxicated, with his 4-year-old son in the back seat. He was booked into jail on charges of vehicular eluding, failure to remain at the scene of an accident, child abuse, and driving under the influence.
