SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-5164

On Nov. 11, officers were notified that a vehicle associated with a prior case was in the area. The case involved a male suspect who used counterfeit money to purchase items at Lowe's and later returned them at a different Lowe's location for real cash. Acting on this information, officers located the vehicle nearby and conducted a traffic stop. Their investigation confirmed that the driver, a 22-year-old male, was the same suspect from the earlier case. He was taken into custody without incident and booked into the Adams County Jail on charges of forgery and theft.

Case Report 24-6681

At 3 p.m. on Nov. 15, officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle with no tab stickers on the rear plates. During the stop, officers noticed an open box of wine and the smell of alcohol coming from the vehicle. The driver complied when asked to step out of the vehicle. During the investigation, officers found the driver in possession of a loaded firearm, and another loaded firearm was discovered inside the vehicle. Both guns were determined to be stolen. The driver and passenger, both males, were arrested and later booked into the Adams County Jail.

Case Report 24-6699

At 1:42 p.m. on Nov. 16, officers were dispatched to a physical disturbance at Maverik in the 5100 block of East Bromley Lane. The reporting party stated that someone had broken into a box truck and was now physically fighting with the truck's owner. Officers arrived quickly, and the suspect fled on foot after being instructed to stop. Following a brief foot pursuit, the suspect was taken into custody. The 41-year-old male was booked into the Adams County Jail on charges of criminal trespassing, assault, and other offenses.

Case Report 24-6721

On Nov. 17 around 5 p.m. officers responded to the 5100 block of Longs Peak Street for a disturbance with weapons. A male had reportedly discharged a weapon into the lawn in front of his house. Two children were reported to have been outside at the time of the incident. The 42-year-old male was arrested and booked into Adams County jail for possession of a weapon by a previous offender, reckless discharge, prohibited use of a weapon, and child abuse.
