### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

#### Case Report 24-6988

On Dec. 1 around 11 p.m., an off-duty Brighton officer reported a suspicious, occupied vehicle parked at Target. Officers quickly responded and found the vehicle unoccupied and without license plates. After checking the VIN, they determined it was a stolen rental car out of Greeley. While on scene, officers spotted a male matching the suspect's description outside the store. The suspect then ran back inside, and loss prevention staff saw him flee through the back of the store, triggering the alarm. Additional officers arrived, located the suspect on the south side of the building, and took him into custody. The 32-year-old male was processed and booked into Adams County Jail for motor vehicle theft, among other charges.

#### Case Report 24-7007

A 57-year-old male suspect was caught stealing a paint sprayer and painter's tape from Home Depot, with the value of the stolen items elevating the theft to felony status. Officers quickly intervened and apprehended the suspect without incident. He was processed and booked into Adams County jail. The case was presented to the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Office and they accepted the following charges:

COUNT 1: THEFT, C.R.S. 18-4-401 (1), (2)(f) (F6)

COUNT 2: SECOND DEGREE BURGLARY, C.R.S. 18-4-203(1), (2)(c) (M2)

#### Case Report 24-7022

A road rage incident escalated when a 23-year-old male suspect pointed a firearm at two victims. When contacted, the suspect denied the allegations and had his girlfriend remove the firearms from the area. Following a thorough investigation, officers located the girlfriend within the city. Despite overwhelming evidence contradicting his claims, the suspect continued to deny the allegations. Both individuals were arrested and booked into Adams County Jail. The case was presented to the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Office and they accepted the following charges:

#### Case Report 24-7055

Officers were dispatched to Walmart on a report of a stolen truck and trailer in the parking lot. The investigation revealed that the victim's truck and trailer had been stolen in Commerce City at 1 a.m. Around 2 p.m., the victim received a call from the thieves, demanding \$3,000 for the return of his property. The suspects instructed the victim to meet at the Walmart in Brighton. After arriving, the victim's family lost contact with him, and his wife received a phone call claiming the victim was being held hostage and would be killed if the money wasn't sent immediately. Believing the voice to be her husband's, she drove to Brighton. Officers located the victim safely nearby and determined that the suspects had used AI to clone his voice. The call originated from a foreign number accessed through an app. The stolen truck and trailer remain missing.
