### **SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS**

#### Case Report 24-7232

At 1:20 a.m. on Dec. 14 officers were dispatched to an auto-pedestrian crash near the unit block of North Main Street. A 22-year-old male was crossing the street and was hit by a Toyota Tacoma driven by a 28-year-old male. The pedestrian had minor injuries and was found to be intoxicated. The driver of the truck had fled the scene, but officers were able to locate him a short time later. The driver was arrested for driving under the influence and leaving the scene of a crash.

#### Case Report 24-7262

On Dec. 15 around 9:30 p.m., officers responded to a reported stabbing in the 100 block of South 20th Avenue. A 17-year-old male was arrested at the scene for aggravated assault and attempted murder after allegedly stabbing a 38-year-old male, who was transported to the hospital. Detectives believe this was an isolated incident with no threat to the public. The investigation remains ongoing.

#### Case Report 24-7307

On Dec. 17 at approximately 10:45 p.m., officers responded to a report of shoplifting at Kohl's. Two suspects reportedly fled the store with a cart of merchandise through the emergency exit. Officers were provided with descriptions of the suspects and their vehicle.

The vehicle was quickly located driving on East Bromley Lane. Stop sticks were deployed, and the driver lost control while attempting to avoid them, causing the vehicle to roll.

A male suspect fled the scene on foot, while two female passengers remained on site with non-life-threatening injuries. The vehicle was found to have fictitious license plates, and approximately 30 grams of methamphetamines were recovered nearby.

The male suspect, who was found to have over 20 active warrants, was later located near the 400 block of East Bromley Lane and arrested for shoplifting, obstruction, and several other charges. A 26-year-old female passenger was also arrested for shoplifting. Both suspects were booked into Adams County jail following a medical evaluation.

We're grateful to the reporting party for providing detailed descriptions and to the community members who assisted in the search for the fleeing suspect. Their help was instrumental in ensuring the suspect was apprehended. This incident remains under investigation.
