SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-7305

Case Report 24-7307

On Dec. 17 at approximately 10:45 p.m., officers responded to a report of shoplifting at Kohl's. Two suspects reportedly fled the store with a cart of merchandise through the emergency exit. Officers were provided with descriptions of the suspects and their vehicle.

The vehicle was quickly located driving on East Bromley Lane. Stop sticks were deployed, and the driver lost control while attempting to avoid them, causing the vehicle to roll.

A male suspect fled the scene on foot, while two female passengers remained on site with non-life-threatening injuries. The vehicle was found to have fictitious license plates, and approximately 30 grams of methamphetamines were recovered nearby.


The male suspect, who was found to have over 20 active warrants, was later located near the 400 block of East Bromley Lane and arrested for shoplifting, obstruction, and several other charges. A 26-year-old female passenger was also arrested for shoplifting. Both suspects were booked into Adams County jail following a medical evaluation.

We're grateful to the reporting party for providing detailed descriptions and to the community members who assisted in the search for the fleeing suspect. Their help was instrumental in ensuring the suspect was apprehended. This incident remains under investigation.

Case Report 24-7328

At 9:30 a.m. on Dec. 19, officers conducting extra patrols observed a vehicle committing a traffic violation. A traffic stop was initiated, revealing the driver had an active warrant. Further investigation uncovered that the driver and passenger were in possession of more than 98 grams of

methamphetamine, 5 grams of crack cocaine, and 38 grams of fentanyl. A 36-year-old man and a 30-year-old woman were arrested and booked into the Adams County Jail.



Case Report 24-7347

A hit-and-run incident was reported near 124th Avenue and northbound Highway 85, with multiple callers stating a USPS truck sideswiped vehicles and scattered packages across the roadway. The vehicle was later found abandoned at South 1st Avenue and Fulton Drive, where witnesses reported seeing a male suspect fleeing northbound. Officers located the suspect near 3rd Avenue and Egbert Street, and he was taken into custody.
