SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 24-7549

On Dec. 31, Officers responded to I-76 near E-470 for a multi-vehicle crash. A snowstorm made the interstate extremely icy, contributing to the crashes. One driver was transported to the hospital after the truck they were driving rolled over.



Case Report 25-0002

On Jan 1, just after midnight, officers were dispatched to a report of a disturbance at a residence on S. Main St. Officers learned that a 44-year-old male got into an argument with his estranged girlfriend. During the argument, the male reportedly threatened the female with a knife. The male was arrested on charges of domestic violence and felony menacing. The female was unharmed.

Case Report 25-0011

On Jan 1 at about 8:00 pm, Officers were dispatched to the Pavilions on reports of people breaking into cars. As officers investigated those vehicle break-ins, another call came in about vehicle prowlers near the McDonald's at Bromley and Kuner Rd. The suspects' descriptions matched those given for the break-ins at the Pavilions. When officers responded, the suspects fled on foot but were captured after a short foot pursuit. The suspects were found to be juveniles. They were arrested and processed at the police department.

Case Report 25-0036

On Jan 3 at 7:45 pm, Officers were dispatched to Brighton Park, 900 Midland St, on reports of a suspicious vehicle circling the area. Officers located the car and found that it was an active stolen vehicle from Arapahoe County. The driver was also found to be in possession of suspected methamphetamine. The driver, a 39-year-old female, was arrested on charges of motor vehicle theft and other felonies.



Case Report 25-0014

On Jan 2, just before 1 a.m., officers were conducting proactive patrols and made a traffic stop for a traffic violation. The driver was arrested for driving on a revoked license and other traffic charges. The officer found the driver had 6.3 grams of M30 Fentanyl pills. The driver was later booked into the Adams County Jail on the traffic and drug charges.
